

Subject : Completion of GPF, State Insurance and NPS accounts.

Respected Ma'am,

1. Your kind attention is invited towards the following issues:-

- (i) **Scanning & Digitization** : we have completed the process of scanning and digitization of GPF and State Insurance records of all the employees, alongwith All India Service Officers (PF) accounts, on pilot basis in the districts of Jhunjhunu, Jhalawar and New Delhi. For rest of the district offices, the process for scanning and digitization of the aforesaid records is to be undertaken shortly. During the scanning and digitization process, it was found that a number of entries are missing in various GPF and State Insurance accounts of the employees. Keeping in view the experience, we have already provided the facility to make the final payment on the basis of entries made in the GPF Pass Book or State Insurance Record Book, as the case may be. We are in process to explore centralized system for state insurance policies of the AIS Officers.
- (ii) **Online Payments** : the department has already started online payments under the GPF and State Insurance policies to all State Government employees, including AIS Officers, through SIPF Portal w.e.f. 15<sup>th</sup> August, 2016.
- (iii) **NPS** : the National Pension System (NPS) is applicable to all State Government employees appointed on or after 01.01.2004 and governed by the statutory provisions of PFRDA Act, 2013 and it's Regulations, 2015. The Pension Fund Regulatory & Development Authority (PFRDA) has instituted awards in the following categories :-

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award ceremony on 19th December, 2016. We stood runner up under category-I and III and second runner up under category-II.

2. Following steps are required to be taken :-

(i) Directions to subordinates : kindly issue directions to your subordinate offices to provide posting details w.r.t. missing entries (gaps) to enable us to get the accounts transferred from respective district offices to complete their GPF and SI accounts for prompt payment of claims. DDOs may send the duly verified Pass Books/Record Books to their respective district office of SI & PF Department to update the records.

(ii) AIS (PF) Accounts:

(a) Discrepancy in Accounts : I would also request you to visit your AIS (PF) account and intimate us without delay if any discrepancy is found for necessary updation/corrections. The process to visit (login) your accounts on SIPF Portal is :

User Name (your employee ID is your user-name)

Pass Word (your date of birth is your pass word). After first login to the SIPF Portal, you may change the pass word.

(b) Transfer of State Service accounts : the AIS officers promoted from the State Services are requested to kindly expedite to submit details of places of posting enabling us to get the accounts transferred from various district headquarters and old account balances to the new account number. We have not received the details of places of posting as per the enclosed list (Annexure-A).

(iii) NPS Issues : Our team is striving hard with their dedicated efforts to fill-up the narrow margin to achieve the top level in implementation of the NPS in the State. Kindly instruct your subordinate authorities to co-operate with the department to enable us to be at top level in all categories as the said PFRDA award is to be continued for this year also.

(iv) Compliance of PFRDA Act and Regulations : It has been observed that many departments / institutions (including SABs) are not complying with the statutory provisions of PFRDA Act, 2013 and it's Regulations, 2015. The NPS subscription amount is not being remitted regularly in respective PRANs of employees which in turn results in legacy amount.

I request your goodself to instruct your subordinate departments/institutes/ organisations for compliance of the PFRDA Act and it's regulations.
