

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Declined child sex ratio is a matter of great concern for the State of Rajasthan. Ultrasonography machine/Imaging machine or any other equipment capable of detecting sex are usually instrumental in prenatal sex determination which cause of female foeticide. The strict implementation of the PC&PNDT Act is the prime duty of the State Government .


In reference to the letter of Government of India No.V.11011/7/2013-PNDT Dated 12.06.2017 and power conferred by Rule 18-A (7) of PC&PNDT Rule 1996 the monitoring of the unauthorized sale /circulation of USG machine/Imaging machine and to curb their misuse, is, hence, the duty of the State Government and, therefore, the following guideline are made & circulated for strict compliance.

Guidelines for the registration of importers, manufacturers, retailers, distributors, dealers etc.

1. All importers, manufacturers, retailers, distributors, dealers etc dealing in sale, purchase, buyback of Ultrasonography machine /Imaging machines in Rajasthan shall be registered with State Appropriate Authority, PCPNDT Govt of Rajasthan. No person shall be permitted for sale/purchase/buy back or carry out any transaction of USG/imaging machine/ probes or any instrument capable of detection of sex of foetus except from the dealers/ manufactures/repairers etc registered with State Appropriate Authority in Govt of Rajasthan. Registration Certificate shall be issued to only genuine Applicant The genuineness of the centre shall be decided by the documents submitted along with registration application.
2. No clinic/doctor shall purchase/ sale / give buy back of any USG machine/imaging machine from /to any manufacturer, retailer, distributor, importer, dealer etc. not registered with State Appropriate Authority, Govt. of Rajasthan.
3. Manufacturers, retailers, distributors, importers, dealers etc shall keep complete record of their business at the place of their business, in serial order regarding the date, make model & serial no. of the USG machine/imaging machines/any other machine capable of detecting sex/ probes sold/bought back/traded & shall submit their quarterly report of sale/buyback etc. to State Appropriate Authority and District Appropriate Authority by e-mail at pcndt-rj@nic.in as well as by hard copy within 15 days of end of every quarter. Even if the information is "Nil", it is to be reported mandatorily.

4. Every manufacturer, importers, retailers, distributors, dealers etc. shall provide reasonable facilities for inspection of their record of the business at the place of their business on demand in case this is necessary for implementation of PC&PNDT Act or in-connection with inquiry by State & Concerned Appropriate Authority during inspection visit at all reasonable times.
5. All sale/purchase/buy back regarding the USG machine/imaging machines/any other machine capable of detecting sex/probes shall be reported to the concerned District/Sub divisional Appropriate Authority by the Clinic/Doctor as well as by concerned Manufacturers, Distributors, Retailers, importers, etc.
6. Manufacture, importer, dealer etc. shall submit the report online. Till this mechanism is developed, reporting shall be made on email id pcpcndt-rj@nic.in and a hard copy shall be submitted to the State Appropriate Authority, Directorate of Medical and Health Department Swasthya Bhavan Jaipur, Rajasthan.
7. Standby machine shall be allowed only with permission from concerned Appropriate Authority, the procedure shall be same that of fresh registration of machine.
8. Manufacturer, importer, dealer etc shall report to State Appropriate Authority, Govt. of Rajasthan about the refurbishment or cannibalization of any old equipment purchased from the client.
9. Fees for registration of all manufacturers, distributors, retailers, importers etc. shall be for importers & manufacturer-Rs 100000 (in words one lakh Rupees only) and for distributor, dealer & retailer etc.-Rs 50000 (in words fifty thousand Rupees only) for 5 Years respectively. The fees shall be utilize for effective implementation of PC&PNDT Act including awareness programmes.

All manufacturers, importer, distributors, retailers, importers etc of Ultrasonography machine/ imaging machines/probes any other equipment capable of detecting sex of foetus shall follow the above mentioned instructions strictly, in a bid to stop illegal transactions of Ultrasonography/imaging machines/probe or any other equipment capable of detecting sex. Any non-compliance of these instructions will be viewed as contravention of Sec.3-B of the PC&PNDT Act, 1994 & Rule 3-A of the PC&PNDT Rules 1996 and shall be liable to prosecution by concerned Appropriate Authority.

Subject: Decisions taken in 25th meeting of the Central Supervisory Board (CSB) held on 5th January 2017, under the chairmanship of Hon'ble Minister of Health & Family Welfare-reg.


The undersigned is directed to forward herewith the minutes of the 25th meeting of the Central Supervisory Board (constituted under the Pre-conception and Prenatal Diagnostic Techniques Act (PC&PNDT Act, 1994) on 5th January 2017, under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble HFM.

The Central Supervisory Board (CSB), in its 25th meeting held on 5th January 2017, under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Minister of Health & Family Welfare has made following recommendation:-

All States/ UTs may register the manufacture, importer, dealer and supplier of ultrasound machines / imaging machines or any other equipment capable of detecting sex of the foetus at the state level for better monitoring of sale of ultrasound machines to the registered facilities under PC&PNDT Act besides keeping a check on the unauthorised/unregulated ultrasound machines sold and being used in the State/ UTs without any information to the concerned District Appropriate Authorities. The state may ensure that the manufacturer, importer, dealer and supplier are complying with the Section 3 B and Rule 3 under PC&PNDT Act.

This system would be interim arrangement, till ultrasound machines/ imaging machines or any other equipment capable of detecting sex of the foetus is notified and regulated under the Medical Devices Rules, 2017

In view of the above recommendation, it is requested to take further necessary steps in this regard
