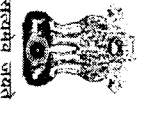

Monthly PHC Recognition Program

Goal: Effective mechanism required to maintain a balance between coverage and exclusivity

Objective: Recognize Top Performing PHC per district per month based on a pre-decided criteria

Background: Team recognition is considered as an effective mechanism to drive performance based on the following reasons:

Motivation:

- Appreciation for hard work through transparent & objective recognition
- Drive to achieve tangible goals
- Maintain balance between coverage & exclusivity

Team Work:

- Collaborative work-environment for working towards a common goal
- Build collective ownership and reduced blame-game

Peer Learning:

- Peer to peer leaning and sharing best practices
- Create platform for mentorship

Data Source: PCTS, e-Aushadhi and mSNA

Criteria Used for Selection:

Objective scoring based on data from the above information sources:

- Utilization: OPD, Delivery and Increase over last year
- Coverage: ANC, Immunization
- Reporting – MNDY, MNJY, PCTS
- Staff attendance: mSNA

Any PHC achieving below 70% score to not get awarded (even if first in district)
