WHO has declared the recent COVID-19 epidemic as Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC). Till date it has affected 150 countries with majority of them in China, Iran, Italy, South Korea, Germany, France, Spain, Japan, Thailand, Singapore, Hong Kong and UAE, Qatar, Oman, Kuwait, Afghanistan, Philippines and Maldives. In Rajasthan 37 cases are reported (2 Italian, 6 Jaipur, 17 Bhilwara, 01 Sikar, 04 Jodhpur, 01 Pali, 02 Prtapgarh & 4 from Jhunjhunu). Out of these Thirty Seven positive Three are declared negative during their course of treatment.

- No. of passengers screened till 21.03.20 :- 34341 (244- flights)

Helpline:

- State has strengthened the Surveillance and Control measures against the disease. State Helpline 0141-2225624 and Toll free No. 108 & 104 is functional.

Isolation wards and quarantine facilities:

- Separate isolation wards and quarantine facilities have been earmarked in all the districts of the state (974 beds for isolation in DH / SDH and Quarantine beds 2839)
- RUHS Hospital at Jaipur has been identified as quarantine center for suspects.

Contact Tracing:

- 765 Persons who came in contact with COVID-19 positive cases were identified and kept under surveillance.

Inter-departmental coordination:

- Department has coordinated with all the departments of GoR. The advisory regarding IEC, Screening, Preventive measures such as Disinfection, temporary suspension of use of Bio-metric Attendance and Breath analyzer as well as precautions in permitting mass gatherings has been issued.
- Department also coordinated with Railways and Defense for establishing Isolation wards / Quarantine facilities, Proper IEC & BCC with obtaining self declaration from foreign travelers.

Training and IEC:

- State level training is conducted for district ToT's for COVID-19 in two parallel batches. Four participants as district ToT's from each district are trained in this training. Training was organized by national ToT's who had training at Shanti Swaroop auditorium, New Delhi on 06 March, 2020. SMO of WHO also attended in this State level training.
- Training is being carried out for doctors, Para-medical staff, and frontline workers such as ASHA / ANM.
- Intensified IEC activities are being carried out through posters/pamphlets/hoardings/print media/mass messaging / miking by ULBs.

Rapid Response Team:

- Rapid Response Teams have been constituted in all the districts and has been trained and oriented.
