Subject: Rationalisation of Staff for implementation of Mukhya Mantri Nishulk Janch Yojana

The State government had launched Mukhya Mantri Nishulk Janch Yojana on 7<sup>th</sup> April 2013 under which all Medical Colleges /District Hospitals /Satellite Hospitals extended the benefits of MNJY to the patients. Similarly Phase II was launched on 1<sup>st</sup> July 2013 at the Community Health Centre level.

The III Phase of this endeavour would cover all Primary Health Centres with effect from 15<sup>th</sup> August 2013.

Recently, for the successful implementation of this programme 241 doctors were appointed after being selected from Rajasthan University of Health Sciences and have been posted in various PHCs. Another 196 specialists will also be joining posting places very soon.

However, on account of various reasons there may be some institutions in your district where the posts are still lying vacant. In this regard you may kindly refer letter dated 20.07.13 of Director (PH) and dated 20.07.2013 of Addl. Director (Admn) and 28.07.13 of Principal Secretary Health.

The Medical and Health Department vide order dated 28.07.2013 has empowered District Collectors for rationalizing the doctors (Medical Officers and Specialists) so as to optimally utilize the human resources available in the districts with the concurrence of Hon'ble Chief Minister and Hon'ble Health Minister. District Collectors shall also ensure the rationalization of the nursing / para medical staff (GNM, ANM, Pharmacist, LT, and Radiographer) following the same principle of rationalization for optimally utilizing the human resources.

You may kindly ensure the compliance of the above directions so as to successfully implement the flagship health schemes of the State Government.
