Subject: National capacity building- training of doctors on substance use disorders

Dear Sir,

This is in continuation of the correspondence from Ministry of Health and FW Ref DO.NO.X.11029-2-2011-DDAP, dated 2.2.2011 sent to your office on the above subject.

We have been entrusted by the GO for a national exercise on "National capacity building of medical professionals on treatment of substance use disorders". This would be coordinated by our centre. The activity entails conducting Training programmes on Substance Use Disorders (nine days duration) at the zonal level for General duty Medical doctors working in district hospitals. In this regard, besides our centre NDDTC, AIIMS we have proposed the following centres as the nodal centre for each region.

1. Govt. Medical College, Chandigarh
2. NIMHANS, Bangalore
3. KEM hospital, Mumbai
4. RIMS, Imphal
5. CIP, Ranchi

By end of year 2013, each nodal centre has to conduct 6 courses. Two courses are to be conducted by each institute in a year leading to about 30 doctors being trained annually with 15 participants in each course. A budget has been finalised and funds for the courses would be sent from our centre.

Each nodal centre has been assigned the states from where the medical doctors need to be invited. We hereby seek your cooperation for the nomination of doctors as and when requested by the above institutions

As part of its initiatives under the Drug De-addiction Programme, the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare is undertaking a capacity building exercise to enhance the capability of staff working in the District/Civil hospitals across the country to detect and manage substance use disorder (drug addiction).
