

**Sub; Intensifying screening of Influenza A H1N1 Cases**

As you are aware that early identification and treatment of suspected Influenza A H1N1 cases is vital for prevention and control of disease in State. Early identification of cases before it progresses to respiratory complications and administration of antiviral can prevent further complications and mortality due to said disease. In view of the above following actions are to be ensured at your level:

1. Early use of X-ray for all suspected cases is to be taken at all screening centers.
2. Medical Mobile Units under NRHM to be utilized for early X-ray in the areas where facilities are non-existent.
3. Early and judicious use of pulse oxymeter to be taken for timely shifting of cases to ventilator.
4. Strict implementation of Infection Control Practices to prevent cross infection is to be monitored by PMOs personally.
5. Bio-medical waste management is to be monitored strictly on daily basis by PMO.
6. Contact tracing of all positive cases to be done within 24 hours. Report of the same to be conveyed to centre cell by 6.00 PM positively.
