**Sub: Regarding preparedness of Second Phase of Swine Flu
A(H1N1) in Rajasthan.**

As you are aware that recently a positive case has been diagnosed in Jodhpur district.

You are already aware about the nature of the disease for which you have taken steps to prevent & control the spread of the disease last year.

Guidelines for treating the disease have already given to you, so make it sure that each & every patient of ILI (Influenza like illness) is being treated, investigated & referred to referral unit accordingly & promptly as per guidelines.

1. Continue the separate OPD with its separate entry from outside for Influenza like illness (Swine Flu) patients at all govt. Institutions.
2. Daily reporting of ILI patients of all the Health Institutions and Screening report of Schools to be ensured.
3. Start the IEC activities (Electronic & Print Media, Hoardings) up to the village health level. Of overriding priority is activation of IEC campaign highlighting for those suffering from Influenza like illness to report to identified health care facility and for the community to follow simple public health measures that limits transmission.
4. Make sure the availability of the medicines (oseltamivir) & the logistics. Stock position of necessary drugs and UC of vaccine to be reported regularly.
5. Make sure that the health workers up to village health services are vaccinated.

6. Keep vigilance on any positive case, death & take immediate action to prevent its spread by giving prophylactic treatment to all contacts and take other necessary actions.
7. Mobile Teams to be reconstituted and make it functioning with immediate effect.
8. All concerned health workers, private health agencies and School Teachers related to the disease to be trained/ re-trained.
9. Ensure the availability of Swine flu medicines at all authorised private shops.
10. Make sure that the 108 Ambulance facility is in working condition & available for transporting the patients.
11. Make sure that the control room is fully functional round the clock. All incoming messages to be recorded and prompt action to be taken as per requirement with information to Higher Authorities.
12. The free investigation facility for the BPL patients, pregnant women's, senior citizens, children's below 5 years of age will continue.
13. Reserve 8 beds for isolation in each District Hospitals and separate ICU ward with fully functioning ventilators and other necessary equipments.
