Circular

There have been some cases of Influenza A/H1N1 virus among students and staff in certain schools. There has been considerable speculation over the need for closure of schools/colleges to control the outbreak. This matter has been discussed at Govt. level and it is decided that whenever a positive case is found the school/college should be closed.

In view of the residential schools/colleges, if a positive case found in residential school/college, the children will go to their homes and they may carry with them Swine flu virus within state and outside state. To avoid this situation, Govt. has decided that residential schools/colleges may not be closed and the students may be screened by the Medical team in the school and whosoever found positive may be given medicine. The positive case may be isolated and kept in a separate room of the hostel under the supervision of the doctor.

All schools/colleges are instructed to implement the guidelines prescribed by GOI for managing cases of infection of Influenza A/H1N1 in the jurisdiction of concerning District Collector.
