Sub.: Early detection of Influenza A (H1N1) cases.

For better management & to reduce morbidity and mortality in Influenza-A (H1N1) cases early detection & treatment of these cases is of utmost importance.

All concerns to ensure that whenever Influenza-A (H1N1) suspects report in OPD or referred to hospitals, thorough screening of these suspects is to be done and if required samples for Testing should be collected at the earliest.

Special attention should be given to vulnerable groups such as children, pregnant women, Old age patients, Diabetics and those who are presenting disease with other complications.

Management of Cat-B patients of Influenza-A (H1N1) should be done as per guidelines and earliest.
