2. Coordinate with Drug Control Organization and prepare an action plan for monitoring with time-bound activities. RMRS rules/guidelines may be amended accordingly (if required).
3. Constitute a committee of technical experts, representative from Drug Control Organization and finance/accounts persons to review the procurement procedure under RMRS and local purchase to suggest measures to ensure transparency in procurement and strict quality control.
4. Please put up action-taken report within 7 days.
