Following amendments are hereby issued to the RFP published by RSHAA for selection of Insurance Company for Ayushman Bharat-Mahatma Gandhi Rajasthan Swasthya Bima Yojana vide no. F-1008(146)III Phase/2019-20/1479 dated 17.10.19:-

Addition Hospitals qualifying for NABH/NQAS entry- level accreditation will receive an additional 10% while those qualifying for full accreditation will receive an additional 15%. Teaching Government hospitals running PG/DNB courses would receive an additional 10% rate. It is clarified that if a hospital is falling in two or more categories of incentives it will not be entitled for multiple incentives, highest single percentage of incentive will be given to that hospital.

(f) at page 23	If the Insurer's average claim ratio for the full 12 months is in excess of 115%, then the RSHAA will be liable to pay 50% of additional claim cost in excess of the total premium already paid by it and remaining 50% shall be borne by the Insurance Company.

Above clauses shall be incorporated in the final agreement to be executed between RSHAA and successful bidder.
