Jhalawar Medical College is run by Jhalawar Hospital and Medical College Society which is fully owned and controlled by Government of Rajasthan. All members of the society are Government employees. Out of 100 MBBS Seats, 85 seats are filled through PMT while 15 seats will be filled from NRI quota.

Walk In Interview will be held for NRI seats of MBBS course at Jhalawar Medical College, Jhalawar for the academic session 2008-09, from eligible son / daughter / ward of a Non-Resident Indian.

Candidates must have passed 10+2 Senior Secondary examination of the Indian School certificate examination or equivalent examination or acquired qualification which is equivalent to 10+2 Examination after a period of 12 years study, the last two years of study comprising Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English. The candidate must have obtained an aggregate of 50% (40% for SC/ST/OBC) in Physics, Chemistry and Biology and pass marks in English.

Eligible candidates can directly appear along with application form and original documents before the selection Board on 29th September 2008 at 1:00 PM in Swasthya Bhanwan, Tilak Marg, C- Scheme, Jaipur

Admission to NRI seats of MBBS Course 2008-09

Jhalawar Medical College is run by Jhalawar Hospital and Medical College Society which is fully owned and controlled by Government of Rajasthan. All members of the society are Government employees. Out of 100 MBBS Seats, 85 seats are filled through PMT while 15 seats will be filled from NRI quota.

Applications are invited for NRI seats of MBBS course at Jhalawar Medical College, Jhalawar for the academic session 2008-09, from eligible son / daughter / ward of a Non-Resident Indian.

Eligibility:-

- (a) Candidates must have passed 10+2 Senior Secondary examination of the Indian School certificate examination or equivalent examination or acquired qualification which is equivalent to 10+2 Examination after a period of 12 years study, the last two years of study comprising Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English.

The candidates must have passed in the subject of Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English individually and must have obtained a minimum of 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology at the qualifying examination as mentioned in clause (2) of regulation 4 of Graduate Medical Education 1997, Medical Council of India. In respect of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes or Other Backward Classes, the marks obtained in Physics, Chemistry and Biology taken together in qualifying examination be 40% instead of 50% as above.

- (b) The candidate must complete 17 yrs of age on or before 31st December 2008.
- (c) The candidate must be medically fit, the fitness will be ascertained by The Medical Board constituted by the college.
- (d) The candidate must furnish a declaration on Rs. 100/- Non-Judicial Stamp that he / she is son / daughter / ward of a Non-Resident Indian.

Jhalawar Medical College is run by Jhalawar Hospital and Medical College Society which is fully owned and constructed by Government of Rajasthan out of 100 seats, 85 are filled through PMT while 15 belong to NRI Quota. Jhalawar Medical College Society issues the following guidelines for filling the NRI quota of MBBS admissions to Jhalawar Medical College starting from the academic session 2008-09.

- (1) For providing maximum opportunity to the eligible candidates of NRI category living and / or studying in the country and / or abroad a wide publicity will be made through media including international media well in time including the DMHS website: **rajswasthya.nic.in.**
- (2) **Eligibility: - According to MCI Graduate Medical Education Regulations 1997 and Ordinance 272 of Rajasthan University of Health Sciences.**

Candidates must have passed 10+2 Senior Secondary examination of the Indian School certificate examination or equivalent examination or acquired qualification which is equivalent to 10+2 Examination after a period of 12 years study, the last two years of study comprising Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English.

The candidate must have passed in the subject of Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English individually and must have obtained a minimum of 50% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology at the qualifying examination as mentioned in clause (2) of regulation 4 of Graduate Medical Education 1997, Medical Council of India. In respect of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes or Other Backward Classes, the marks obtained in Physics, Chemistry and Biology taken together in qualifying examination be 40% instead of 50% as above.
