NOTIFICATION


Whereas it is expedient to make provision for the prevention of the outbreak or spread of dangerous epidemic diseases in the State of Rajasthan.

And whereas, the State Government of Rajasthan has ascertained that the Influenza A (H1N1) constitutes a dangerous communicable disease which has the potential of assuming epidemic proportions unless special measures are taken in the State of Rajasthan.

Now, therefore in supersession of this Department Notification No. F. 3(8)MPH/65/Gr-II, dated 4-12-65, published in Rajasthan Gazette, Part IV-C, Ordinary, dated 17-2-1966 and, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) read with sub-section (4) of section 2 of the Rajasthan Epidemic Diseases Act, 1957 (Rajasthan Act 31 of 1957), the State Government hereby empowers all the Collectors of the districts to exercise in relation to their respective districts all the powers exercisable by the State Government under section 2 of the said Act, other than the powers to determine in what manner and by whom any expenses incurred (including compensation if any), shall be defrayed :

Provided that the powers to prescribe regulation under sub-section (1) and (2) of the said section shall be exercised by the collectors of the said Districts in consultation with Director of Medical and Health Services, (Public Health) Rajasthan, Jaipur .
