Global Expression of Interest (EOI)

The Rajasthan State Health Society (RSHS) intends to procure the COVID-19 vaccine on urgent basis. In order to procure the same at the earliest, the RSHS hereby issues this global bid soliciting techno-commercial proposals from the International Manufacturers (from outside India) of COVID-19 Vaccines or their Authorized Agents or from Direct Importers with appropriate license to import the COVID-19 vaccine in India. A bidder may submit their techno-commercial proposals to Mission Director, Rajasthan State Health Society, National Health Mission, Jaipur, Rajasthan (INDIA) through email at md-nrh-m-rj@gov.in latest by 20.05.2021 by 17.00 Hours (IST).

1. General Conditions:

(a) Description of the vaccines to be procured as under:

- Note: 1. Technical data sheet/ Technical specifications details with brochure should be enclosed.
2. Copy of the documents certifying the due approvals by competent authority, i.e. DCGI, of Government of India should be enclosed.

(b) Proposed Deliverable Quantity: As per the confirmed delivery capacity of the Bidder, starting from the date of issue of the Supply Order as per the schedule given below:

Within 5 days	Within 6 - 10 days	Within 11 - 15 days	Within 16 - 20 days	Within 21 - 30 days

Note: The bidders must mention the quantity they can clearly commit for supplies to the Rajasthan State Health Society, National Health Mission, Jaipur, Rajasthan, India in the shortest time within the specified duration, after taking into consideration all necessary factors, including regulatory permissions, due approvals and their present supply commitments under process, if any.

(c) The Conditions for the said procurement are as follows:-

1. The bidders are not required to pay the cost of the bidding document and may download it from the Departmental website www.rajswasthya.nic.in and <https://sppp.rajasthan.gov.in>.
2. The bidders are not required to submit any bid security for this EOI.
3. The successful bidder(s) shall not be required to submit any performance security.
4. The bidders should not have been blacklisted/ debarred to participate in the bids for medical supplies from any Government Department/Public Sector Undertakings of India.

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5. The bidders shall submit an undertaking that "That the quoted vaccine for COVID-19 has been manufactured/imported by us. We do not have any conflict of interest in the said bidding process."
6. No advance payment shall be made, without the bank guarantee of an equivalent amount.
7. The payment shall be given on prorata basis, corresponding to the delivery of the vaccines made or as per the conditions mutually agreed upon.
8. The rate quoted must be rate per dose of vaccine in INR, inclusive of all taxes, duties, license fees, logistics and transportation charges etc. upto the designated point of supply in Jaipur, Rajasthan, India.
9. The bid validity for the bids quoted shall be for a period of 90 days from the date of opening of bids.
10. Price approved through this bid process shall be valid for six months from the date of issue of supply order.
11. The duly filled bids, with copies of the documents required, shall be submitted to the specified email address only, within the prescribed date and time for the submission of the bid.
12. As this procurement process is for most essential vaccine, hence, the bidders shall appreciate that supply schedule and making them available for the use of people of Rajasthan is the essence of the bid. Therefore, the delivery period of the vaccines shall be the deciding factor in the award of the contract. Further, in order to achieve this objective, the Procuring Entity may also consider to divide the quantities among the bidders for ensuring time-bound availability of the vaccines.
13. Mission Director, Rajasthan State Health Society, National Health Mission, Jaipur reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the bids received in this procurement process, without assigning reasons.

2. Specific Conditions:

(a) ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

International Manufacturers (from outside India) of COVID-19 Vaccines or their Authorized Distributors / Importers with appropriate license to import the COVID-19 vaccine, are eligible to participate in the EOI. The bidders must possess the following-

- (i) The COVID-19 Vaccine to be supplied must be as per the guidelines/ approval issued by Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR), Drugs Controller General of India (DCGI) and Government of India (GoI).
- (ii) The vaccine manufacturer should have own manufacturing licence from vaccine manufacturing country and should hold valid World Health Organization- Good Manufacturing Practices (WHO-GMP) Certificate issued by the licensing authorities for all the premises, from where quoted

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product is being manufactured.

- (iii) For imported drugs, labels and product literature of all quoted product(s) must be submitted with WHO-GMP certificate which is at par with WHO-GMP issued by the authorities of exporting countries like U.S. FDA or equivalent authorities of other Countries etc.

(b) Other technical points, including labelling:-

- i Every batch of vaccines supplied thereby by the successful bidder(s) should have all the requisites approvals and certifications from competent authority/authorities of Government of India.
- ii Valid certificate of analysis of every batch of vaccine delivered shall be enclosed at the time of delivery.
- iii Injection Vials should have flip-off caps.
- iv The labelling of drugs/item should comply with guidelines set forth in the Drugs & Cosmetics Act and Rules applicable in the Country, specifically adhering to:-
- The label should prominently display the International Non-Proprietary Name (INN)/Proper Name or Generic name as per labeling provisions of Drugs and Cosmetics Rules.
 - Name of the drug shall also be mentioned in ENGLISH in primary and secondary packings.
 - The secondary packaging material (box, carton) must be clearly labelled with the names of the item, batch number, manufacturing date, expiry date and the number of units per carton/box.
 - The labels in the case of injectables shall clearly indicate that the preparation is meant for IM, IV, ID, SC etc.
 - Consignment shall be liable for rejection if any tampering with the expiry date is found.
 - Submission of bid for the supply of drugs shall be considered as the consent of bidder that the supply will be prepared and packed with the words "Rajasthan Govt. Supplies - Not for sale" shall be overprinted on primary, secondary & tertiary packing material which will distinguish from the normal trade packing. It must be ensured.
 - In case of imported drugs stamping of the words "**Rajasthan Govt. Supplies - Not for sale**" on secondary and tertiary pack shall be sufficient.
- v Due compliance with all the travel advices by WHO guidelines shall be ensured.
- vi Duly prescribed storage conditions for the vaccine upto the destination point of delivery in Jaipur of product must be complied during transportation and storage.

(c) Supply Conditions:

- The successful bidder shall complete the supplies, as per schedule agreed upon by both the parties to the agreement.
- Each batch of the drug must be supplied with certificate of analysis by Government Lab or any NABL accredited drug testing laboratory approved by Government of India.
- Drug with difference in specification, difference in packing material, difference in drug license number shall not be accepted.
- The residual shelf life of the vaccines supplied by the successful bidder(s) must be as prescribed by the DCGI, Government of India, from the date of its supply at Jaipur, Rajasthan (India).
- Those bidders offering the items requiring special cold storage condition should either have their own cold chain transporting system or should have proper contract with a transporting agent having facilities to transport the drugs under cold chain norms from the manufacturing unit to the respective warehouse of the Corporation/facilities as mentioned in purchase order by complying cold chain norms. The bidders to whom LOI has been placed for the supply of drug requiring special cold storage conditions shall, at the time of submission of agreement, submit self attested Documents to prove that they are having own cold chain transporting system or copy of the contract agreement made with a transporting agent having facilities to transport the drugs under cold chain norms from the manufacturing unit to the respective State Vaccine Store, Jaipur, Rajasthan.

3. Payment Conditions:

- (i) No advance payment shall be made, without the bank guarantee of an equivalent amount.
- (ii) The payment shall be given on prorata basis, corresponding to the delivery of the vaccines made or as per the conditions mutually agreed upon.
- (iii) If no advance is made to the successful bidder, then 90% of the payment to the successful bidder(s) shall be made after successful delivery of the vaccines as per the specifications.
- (iv) If any advance has been made against the bank guarantee as above, then the amount of 90% shall be calculated adjusting the said advance amount.
- (v) The remaining 10% shall be issued after satisfactory delivery and due submission of invoices to the MD, RSHS, NHM, Jaipur.

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4. An agreement shall be entered into with the successful bidder(s) after the acceptance of bid. The name, designation & contact detail (including mobile/phone no.) of the authorized person for submitting EOI and signing contract shall be made available by the bidder.
